HOMEBUYER EDUCATION CLASS REQUIREMENT

One of the NSP eligibility requirements is to complete an 8-Hour HUD approved homebuyer education class. To assist you in fulfilling this requirement, we have listed some of the local agencies offering the class. This requirement must be fulfilled prior to closing on a NSP home. Please do NOT leave the class without getting your certificate of completion! Once you have completed the class, please submit a copy of your certificate to our office.

Due to the popularity of this class, they book up very quickly and sometimes have lengthy waiting periods. Therefore, we strongly suggest that you register for a class as soon as possible.
